

Minutes of a Special Meeting of the Justice Committee

The Justice Committee of the McLean County Board met on Tuesday, May 15, 2001 at 8:50 a.m. in Room 700 of the McLean County Law and Justice Center, 104 W. Front Street, Bloomington, Illinois.

Chairman Sommer called the meeting to order at 8:54 a.m.

Mr. Charles Reynard, State's Attorney, presented a request for approval of the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Grant renewal for the Accelerated Dispositions Program for the Fiscal Years 2000 and 2001 for the State's Attorney's Office.

Chairman Sommer stated that in the future, he hoped that the Grant Renewals would be presented more timely manner. Hopefully, the State will reimburse the County for the money spent out of the General Fund for Fiscal Year 2000.

Motion by Emmett/Kinzinger to recommend approval of a request for the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Grant renewal for the Accelerated Dispositions Program for the Fiscal Years 2000 and 2001 for the State's Attorney's Office.

Mr. Reynard presented a request for approval to amend the contract for professional services with contract Paraprofessional Assistant/Kimberly Reed to two contracts. Chairman Sommer explained that the contract needs to be amended to allow the position to be split between two individuals. Splitting the contract will save the County approximately \$1,000 a week.

Mr. Reynard stated that the position would be split between Ms. Reed and a Student Intern.
